His creative talent won him many awards at State and National levels. Sculptor, artisan and painter, Shri Basak kept his creative spark alive during the dark and devastating days of the pandemic by painting and sculpting and creating figures of Goddesses such as Durga using empty ampules and lids of ampules used for innoculations/vaccinations against Covid 19. This is a strike for re-use and sustainability as well as telling the story of Covid 19.
