This award carries a cash prize of Rs 20,000, medal, angavastram, citation and certificate.

Shri Vinod K.Shakya from Mainpuri, Uttar Pradesh is a master artisan in the delicate craft of tarkashi work. He started doing filigree like craft of inlaying fine brass, copper and silver wires on wood at a very young age. His beautiful table tops, desks and artifacts are densely decorated with nuanced tarkashi work and yet have an ethereal floating look. Vinod K Shakya has trained artisans of tarkashi in skill development programs at a Training Centre which he runs.
